Overview

The Metro Manila Health Research and Development Consortium (MMHRDC), in collaboration with the UP Manila–National Institutes of Health, offers a two-day training workshop for basic training in the application of principles of good clinical practice (GCP) and health research ethics to the performance of specific roles in health research. The course includes an introduction to international guidelines and national regulations in health research, and highlights general research ethical issues such as vulnerability, privacy and confidentiality of health information, risks in protocol implementation, risk-benefit assessment, and informed consent.
